


GRADUATE REPORT





About the Graduate Report

This study is administered annually by the Frost Center for Data and Research, Alumni and Family Engagement, the Boerigter Center for Calling and Career, and Admissions. Alumni are contacted 5-6 months after graduation by email, mail and telephone. This year we had a knowledge rate of 65.8%, with 299 survey responses, 96 from Linkedln and 44 from the National Student Clearing House. Class of 2021 Employment Satisfaction




Class of 2021 Graduate Schools


