MTTC Michigan Tests of Teacher Certification: Basic Skills Test - should be taken during the same semester as ED 220 or ED 225 Subject Area Test - Visual Arts Education Test (#95) to be taken the semester prior to <u>OR</u> during the Professional Education Semester.
