Basic Skills Test – should be taken during the same semester as ED 220 or ED 225

Subject Area Test – Visual Arts Education Test (#95) to be taken the semester prior to <u>OR</u> during the Professional Education Semester.

Due to the competitive nature of the field, the Art Department encourages students to take more coursework than the minimum requirements. Students may also complete the requirements and avoid over-load semesters by taking 1 or 2 May Terms. A ninth semester is also possible.
