- 2. What role or roles do you sense you might be called to play after you graduate from college that could provide leadership to ministries and churches in multicultural settings? What gifts will you bring with you as you lead and serve?
- 3. What activities and opportunities do you think you might like to pursue while you're at Hope College that would help prepare you for church involvement **and** be a way to serve and contribute to the Hope College community?

**LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION:** Ask for one letter of recommendation from someone in your school, church, or community (not a relative) who knows of your interest and involvement in the church or other Christian ministries. The letter should address your potential as a leader in the church and your interest in being involved in multiracial and ethnically diverse ministries. The enclosed Mission Statement of the CrossRoads Scholarship program can be passed on to the person writing the letter. The letter should be e-mailed as an attachment directly to CrossRoads.
