The minor in Early Childhood Education (State code: ZS) for Elementary teachers consists of 27 credits.

Teacher candidates for certification must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) Elementary Exam (Test #103). Teacher candidates are strongly recommended to also take the Early Childhood Education exam (Test #106) for marketability purposes. MTTC content exams should not be taken until 90% of course work in the subject area has been completed. They will receive a total of 10 hours of credit for the combined student teaching experiences (4 credits for Educ 475 and 6 credits for Educ 470, the latter of which is included in the elementary education sequence and is not considered part of the 27 hour minor).
