

ELEMENTARY KINESIOLOGY MINOR FOR TEACHING PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The minor in Kinesiology for Elementary teachers of Physical Education, grades 6-8, (State code: MB) consists of a minimum of 22 credits. Minors will complete student teaching in an all subjects general elementary classroom.

Teacher candidates for certification in Kinesiology at the Elementary level must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) in Physical Education (Test #044). MTTC content exams should not be taken until 90% of course work in the subject area has been completed. The courses below meet State standards and have been selected so that teacher candidates will be well prepared for the test. Knowledge must be demonstrated in the following categories in order to successfully pass the MTTC subject area exam:

2. Movement & Lifelong Physical Activity	27%
3. Growth, Development & Learning	14%
4. Planning, Instruction & Assessment	14%
5. Management, Motivation & Communication	14%
6. Foundations, Reflection, & Professional Collaboration	14%
