

HEALTH EDUCATION MINOR FOR SECONDARY TEACHING

Updated April 2015

The **Health Education minor** (State Code: MA) is intended for Secondary certification students and consists of a minimum of 22 credits.

Teacher candidates for certification in the Health Education minor must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) in Health Education (Test #043). MTTC content exams should not be taken until 90% of course work in the subject area has been completed. The courses below meet State standards and have been selected so that teacher candidates will be well prepared for the test. Knowledge must be demonstrated in the following categories in order to successfully pass the MTTC subject area exam:
