Have experience studying abroad through Hope College or one of its affiliate programs (CIEE, SIT, IES).

Attend Ambassador training sessions

Commit to participating in events throughout the year

Log a total of 20 volunteer hours over the semester

Commit to a minimum of one semester

Be in good academic standing
