Payment Schedule

Rates are per person, based on double occupancy:

Program fee: \$8765

Payments and Refunds:

Deposit due: \$2000 upon registration
Deposit is non-refundable unless program is full and a replacement is found for your registered spot (less any fees).

Interim payment: \$3200 due October 1, 2020

Final payment due: \$3565 due April 1, 2021

Cancellations must be made in writing. There are no refunds for payments made. If Hope College and ODC cancel the program, a full refund of the amount you paid will be issued.

Program fee includes all lodging, discussions led by Travis Williams and Dave Van Wylen, professional naturalist guides, professional photo collection documenting trip experiences and sights, all meals while on the ship and others as listed in the itinerary, complimentary beer and wine during dinner and evenings while on the ship, entry fees to parks and museums, admissions for group activities, ground transportation during the program, taxes, and gratuities to group guides, boat crew, and meal servers.

Airfare is not included in the program fee, allowing participants the flexibility to choose airlines, use frequent flyer miles, and pick travel times and connections that best meet their individual travel needs. We suggest that you or your travel agent contact us to coordinate your flight with the start and end times of the programs since there will be limited times flight choices into Alaska. Alternatively, travel agent support and flight suggestions will be offered by us.

Participants are solely responsible for all expenses not specifically included in the program fee. Examples of excluded expenses are: airfare and airport transfers, excess baggage charges, trip cancellation, trip interruption or lost baggage insurance, laundry, dry cleaning, phone charges, room service or other items of a personal nature including but not limited to alcohol, beverages, and food outside that listed as covered in the itinerary and expenses incurred during free time or non-group activities.
