

Experiential Learning Student Grant Information and Application

GENERAL INFORMATION AND PURPOSE:

Hope College encourages all students to have at least one experiential learning opportunity before graduation. To make this experience possible for more students, we are inviting students to apply for a grant of up to \$2,500 to help off-set the cost of an internship or undergraduate research experience. Priority for the funds are given to students of color and students demonstrating financial need.

WHO CAN APPLY:

All full-time Hope College students who identify as a student-of-color or who demonstrate high financial need are eligible to apply. Financial need will be determined through consultation with the Financial Aid office. Students who do not meet the criteria of the grant need not apply.

THINGS TO KNOW:

Summer applicants: You are NOT required to have an internship or research opportunity already secured at the time of application. You MUST notify Shannon Schans with a letter of hire/appointment once your opportunity is secured in order to receive payment. Students MUST have an opportunity secured and a final notice be given to Shannon Schans on or before 5/1/21.

Payment will be made in two installments with half of the amount being granted at the start of the experience and half being granted at the conclusion of your experience.

Should you be awarded an experiential learning grant, these monies will be paid to you directly. Because these funds serve as a grant, the amount awarded will be subject to governmental taxes. In addition, all awarded grant funds will be reported to Financial Aid.

Please note that by submitting this application, you are giving permission for us to access your financial aid information.

TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL APPLICATION:

Answer all questions honestly and to the best of your ability. With specific questions, please contact Shannon Schans (schans@hope.edu).

Be professional in your communication with the grant coordinators. This is a competitive award and the manner in which you communicate, as well as the quality of your application are important factors in determining award recipients.
