2. Provide a signed copy of your (and your spouse's) 2015 and 2016 federal 1040 tax return/W-2 forms.
3. Provide documentation of income estimates (copies of pay stubs, unemployment stubs, verification of retirement, pensions, Social Security benefits, etc). For loss of employment, also attach a letter from the past employer on company letterhead confirming loss of employment and the effective date.
