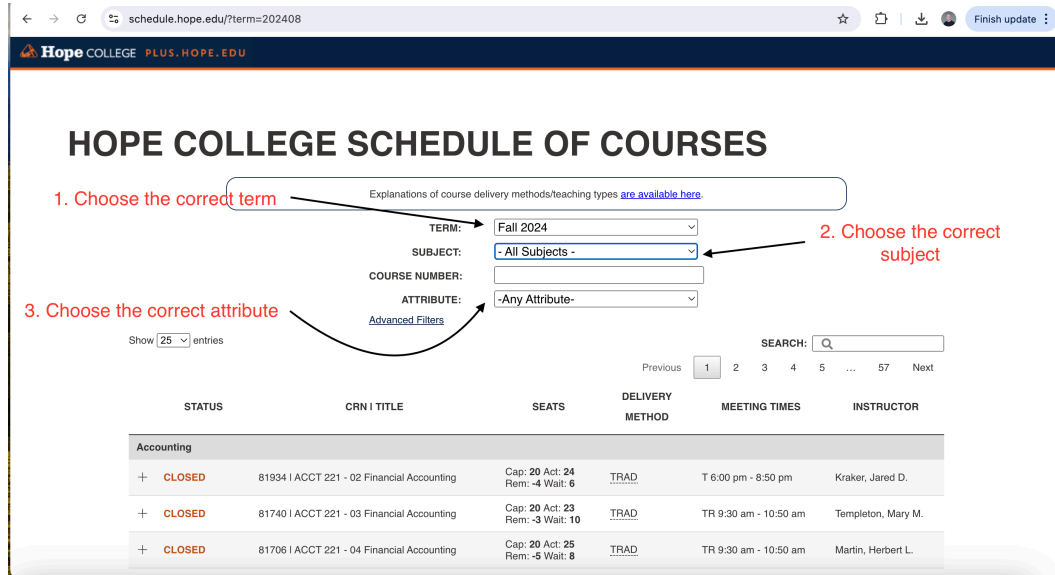

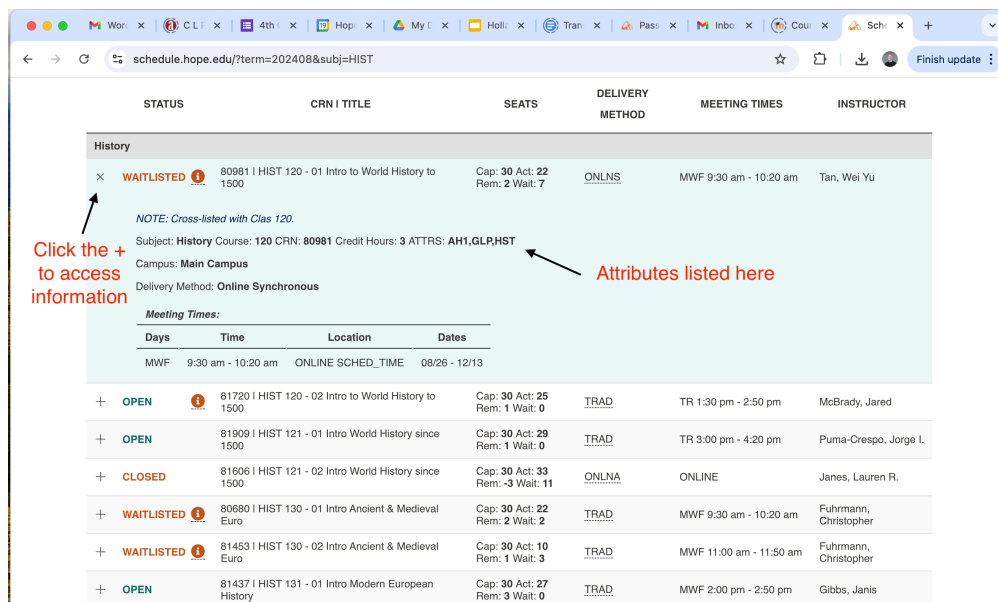

Course Attribute Acronyms

AH1 (Humanistic and Artistic Perspectives 100-level): this includes Historical Perspectives (HST), Philosophical Perspectives (PHL), and Human Creative Perspectives (HCP) all at the 100-level

AH2 (Humanistic and Artistic Perspectives 200-level): this includes Historical Perspectives (HST), Philosophical Perspectives (PHL), and Human Creative Perspectives (HCP) all at the 200-level

ART (Arts in Practice)

EW (Expository Writing): any ENGL 113 section

FYS (First Year Seminar): any IDS 100 section

GLP (Global Perspectives)

HD (Health Dynamics): any KIN 140 section

HST (Historical Perspectives): each of these courses will also have a AH1 or AH2 attribute

HCP (Human Creative Perspectives): each of these courses will also have a AH1 or AH2 attribute

MA (Mathematics): these fall within the category of Mathematics / Natural Science (MNS)

MNS (Mathematics / Natural Science): any course that counts toward the MNS category but is not a MA course and is not a NSL course

NSL (Natural Science with Lab): these fall within the category of MNS

PHL (Philosophical Perspectives): each of these courses will also have a AH1 or AH2 attribute

RL1 (Religion 100-level): these courses might also have a Christian Tenets (TEN) attribute

RL2 (Religion 200-level): these courses might also have a Christian Tenets (TEN) attribute

TEN (Religion Christian Tenets): select courses that also have either the RL1 or RL2 attribute

GL2 (Second Level (or above) Global Language)

SRS (Senior Seminar): any IDS 452 or 492 section

SS (Social Sciences)

USD (United States Diversities)

Attributes mapped: EW, HD, RL2, SS, MNS, MA, NSL, HST/AH2, HCP/AH2, PHL/AH2

Artifacts needed from: none. *ETS Critical Thinking assessment administered in departments.*

Anchor Plan Learning Outcome 6: “Understand key tenets...”

Attributes mapped: TEN

Artifacts needed from: *courses with TEN (collected by Religion Department)*

Anchor Plan Learning Outcome 7: “Explain one’s own values...”

Attributes mapped: RL1, SRS

Artifacts needed from: *SRS courses (Lifeview Papers)*
