Hope

COLLEGE

Hope College is a four-year, co-educational, Christian liberal arts college affiliated with the Reformed Church in America, and during the 2016-17 school year enrolled 3,224 students from 40 states and 28 foreign countries. Founded in 1866 and located in Holland, Michigan, Hope offers majors through more than 50 departments leading to a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Music, Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree.

Hope graduates are educated to think about life's most important issues with clarity, wisdom and a deep understanding of the foundational commitments of the historic Christian faith. They are agents of Hope who live faithfully into their vocations.

Academic excellence and vibrant Christian faith join to strengthen each other in a supportive and welcoming community at Hope. While historically affiliated with the Reformed Church in America, Hope is ecumenically diverse and values open discussion of matters of faith and respect for the opinions of others.

Hope is a recognized leader in collaborative faculty/student research, and has one of the largest summer undergraduate research programs in the nation. Hope's other academic distinctions range from national accreditation in all four of the arts (the first private, four-year, undergraduate liberal arts college in the country to achieve it), to consistently ranking as one of Michigan's top teacher-education programs. Hope is the only college or university in Michigan where business students can participate in the George F. Baker Scholars Program, which provides a wide range of real-world experiences beyond the classroom, and is one of only 286 institutions in the U.S. to have a chapter of Phi Beta Kappa, the nation's oldest scholastic honorary society.

Among other recent external recognition, the 2017 *America's Best Colleges* guide published by *U.S. News and World Report* ranked Hope as one of only 10 national liberal arts colleges (and 36 institutions of all types) notable for providing outstanding undergraduate research/creative project opportunities.

Hope is one of only 11 colleges and universities nationwide highlighted in the website “Supporting STEM Success in a Liberal Arts Context,” which features the schools recognized as Capstone Institutions by the Howard Hughes Medical Institute for the maturity of their programming in striving to strengthen the undergraduate experience in science and mathematics for all of their students. The book *Creative Colleges: A Guide for Student Actors, Artists, Dancers, Musicians and Writers* selected the college’s dance and writing programs as among the best in the nation. Featured in the book *Colleges That Change Lives*, Hope has been named to the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching’s “Community Engagement Classification.”

Hope has approximately 237 full-time and 120 part-time faculty, who publish widely and are involved in many other scholarly and professional activities. Dr. Maria Burnatowska-Hledin, who is the Frederich Garrett and Helen Floor Dekker Professor of Biomedicine and Chemistry, was presented one of two 2016 Janet Andersen Lecture Awards by the Midstates Consortium for Math and Science for her longstanding success in teaching, research, involving students in research and innovative curriculum design. Dr. David S. Cunningham, professor of religion, was named director of the national Network for Vocation in Undergraduate Education (NetVUE) of the Council of Independent Colleges. Dr. Christina Hornbach, professor of music and director of music education, received an Award of Merit from the Michigan Music Education Association for having given exemplary service to the MMEA and music education in Michigan. Edye Evans Hyde, instructor of jazz and director of the Gospel Choir, received the Ethel Coe Humanities Award for exemplifying a passion and talent in the visual and performing arts during the Grand Rapids, Michigan, area’s 35th annual Giants Awards and Banquet Ceremony. Dr. Lindsey Root Luna, associate professor of psychology, received the Regional Faculty Advisor Award for the Midwestern Region of Psi Chi – The International Honor Society in Psychology. Todd Swanson, associate professor of mathematics, and Jill VanderStoep, adjunct assistant professor of mathematics, were among the co-authors of *Introduction to Statistical Investigations*, which received one of seven 2017 Most Promising New Textbook Awards from the Textbook and Academic Authors Association. Dr. Daryl Van Tongeren, assistant professor of psychology, was named a Rising Star in research by the Association for Psychological Science, a recognition most often bestowed on scholars at institutions with graduate-level programs.

Located adjacent to downtown Holland, the campus spans 150 acres, with facilities totaling more than 1.8 million square feet. The most recent additions are the Jack H. Miller Center for Musical Arts (2010), the Kruizenga Art Museum (2015) and the Jim and Martie Bultman Student Center (2017).
