<b>MAJOR VIOLATION</b>	<b>UNACCEPTABLE</b>
Criminal Type Conviction within the last 5 years <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Negligent Homicide</li> <li>• Manslaughter</li> <li>• Failure to Stop and Identify (Hit and Run)</li> <li>• Suspended or Revoked License</li> <li>• Drag Racing</li> </ul> Driving Under the Influence within the last 5 years Driving while Impaired within the last 5 years Reckless Driving within the last 5 years Careless Driving within the last 5 years Assault involving a motor vehicle Passing a stopped school bus	3 or more violations within last 3 years 2 or more At-Fault accidents within last 3 years Violations and accidents combined: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 At-Fault accident and 1 violation within the last 3 years when not the same incident.</li> </ul> <b>Moving Violations:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Speeding violations</li> <li>Improper or excessive lane changes</li> <li>Following the vehicle ahead too closely</li> <li>At-Fault accidents</li> <li>Running a red light or stop sign</li> <li>Failure to yield</li> <li>Etc.</li> </ol> Not at fault accidents, seat belt and failure to register vehicle are not considered moving violations but may be unacceptable.
<b>ACCEPTABLE</b>	
The driver has violations but does not meet the MAJOR or UNACCEPTABLE criteria.	
<b>CLEAN</b>	
No violations listed on the MVR	

#### **At-Fault Accident**

- Any accident where the driver is cited with a violation or negligently contributes to the incident;

OR

- Any single vehicle accident that is not caused by (actual) equipment failure.
